Surface Water Appropriations information

The following information/disclaimer applies to the registered groundwater well related data we are providing as a service. The Nebraska Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has prepared the digital representation of groundwater well locations as part of its statutory responsibility to register water wells in Nebraska. If you, the recipient of this dataset, or excerpts therefrom, are not familiar with the current and historical requirements for water well registrations, then it is possible the data will be misinterpreted and results of analyses that utilize the datasets may not be reliable. For instance, domestic water wells were not required to be registered before September 9, 1993. There is not a requirement for these particular wells to be registered if they were completed before that date. Any person or entity who consumes this dataset must decide if the data are appropriate for their uses and assume responsibility for any misapplication of the information received.

Water well registration information, including location information, is not independently verified by the water well registration staff. This is a registration program, not a certification program. We expect water well professionals and water well owners to comply with state law and provide accurate information on the water well registrations forms. We correct errors when they are verified by the responsible parties. In addition, we discover data entry errors, which are corrected as they are discovered.

Location information from older water wells may be based upon a ¼ ¼ Section legal description in the format of the Public Land Survey System. Therefore, the location displayed on the World Wide Web maps may be approximations from a mathematical computation of the legal description. Certain legal determinations are based upon the registered location, so it is important for anyone with an ownership interest to notify the Department on the proper form when updated water well information needs to be recorded.
