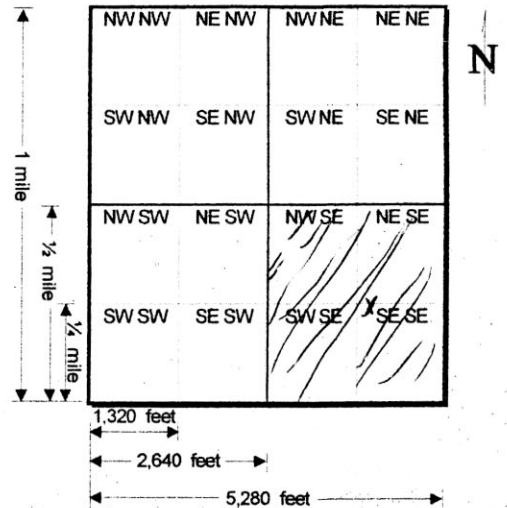

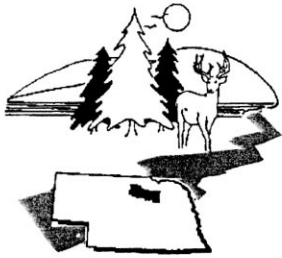

Dear Mr. Schindler,

The application for the construction of irrigation well located in the SE¹/₄ of Section 2, Township 26N, Range 6W has been reviewed by the Upper Elkhorn Natural Resource District. The District finds that the proposed well is in compliance with District rules and regulations. In accordance with this finding, the District has approved the application and granted a permit to construct a well as described in the application at the location stated above. This permit is effective for a period of one (1) year from the date of issue unless this permit conflicts with state law. Should the location of this proposed well change, please contact the District prior to beginning construction.

The issuance of this permit does not relinquish the applicant from also registering the water well with the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) following construction. In addition, it is still the responsibility of the applicant to meet all local, state, and federal regulations pertaining to the construction and development of the proposed water well. The District assumes no liability for any violation of these regulations through the issuance of this permit.

Special attention should be considered to current legislation by all those responsible with irrigation well construction, operation, and maintenance. There is a potential for a two year moratorium on all irrigation development including both Surface and Ground water sources. Senator Gail Kopplin of Gretna has introduced a bill that could impact any new development taking place in 2007. The NRD would like to encourage any interested parties to communicate with their representative the main senators in the UENRD are Vickie McDonald, M.L. Dierks, Deb Fischer or to the proposing Senator Gail Kopplin.
