

Dear Mrs. Roth:

We are returning to you the ground water application received in this office recently for the reason that you failed to enclose the \$5.00 filing fee. You also failed to include the information asked for under paragraph 5, paragraph 8, paragraph 9 and on the plat, which is a part of the application.

Under paragraph 5 you should show the legal sub-division in which your well is located. Under paragraph 8 you should show the land being irrigated from the well, and under paragraph 9 you failed to show the date the well was drilled. This paragraph is very important, as it is reasonable to believe the date the well was drilled would be used as evidence to establish a priority if, and when legislation is enacted governing the use of ground water for irrigation. We also note that you failed to fill in and sign the plat, which is a part of the ground water application.

Upon receipt of the corrected application and the filing fee your application will be filed upon our records.
