
Dear BACE Farms LLC:

Construction of the above-listed well identified as a replacement water well was completed on June 25, 2014. The registration process was placed in a suspended status and, at this point, the new well is illegal. The actions that need to occur in order to have the new well registration process completed depend on what was done to either decommission or modify the original well and when that occurred. If nothing was done to the original well, there are still actions that need to occur in order to complete the registration of the new (replacement) well.

The Department of Natural Resources (NeDNR) has not received a decommissioning or modification form for the original well, so the replacement well cannot be taken out of "Suspense" status. Once NeDNR receives a decommissioning or modification form for the original well from the driller, the replacement well will get taken out of suspense status and be a fully registered, legal well. Until the actions described above are completed, the wells are **not properly registered** and are illegal. Please work with your local NRD and water well contractor to get this situation resolved.

We appreciate your assistance in keeping our records updated. If NeDNR has not received the necessary documentation within 45 days of the date of this letter, it will request the NRD to take further action.
